Two people from the world of literature and art celebrate 250th anniversaries in 2025.

Joseph Mallord William Turner

was born on 23rd April 1775 and

Jane Austen

on 16th December 1775

The Regency Era in British History cover the last third of the Georgian period from 1795—1837.

The Regency Act of 1811 appointed George III's son, the Prince of Wales as the Prince Regent. He succeeded his father as George IV after his death in 1820.

The Nelson Garden therefore fits nicely into this period with its gravel walks, the 1802 island flower bed, rose beds, fruit trees and pavilion seating. The gloomy, damp chill of the arched tunnel entrance gives a sense of vague apprehension before the garden is revealed in sunshine to the visitor. We could perhaps do with some white trellis and a shell grotto, but not sure we'd go as far as to plant Austen's favourite tree; the Laburnum!
